Pre-op and Post-op Instructions for Superficial Peels

Glycolic Acid, Salicylic Acid, SkinCeuticals MicroPeel, SkinCeuticals MicroPeel Plus, Illuminize, Vitalize Peels, Rejuvinize Peels, SkinCeuticals Advanced Peel, & SkinCeuticals Smart TCA

Before Treatment

- Avoid the following procedures for one week prior to your peel:
 - A. Electrolosis B. Waxing C. Depilatory Creams
- Stop using tretinoin, Retin-A, Tazorac, Fabior, Renova, Aklief, Altreno, Arazlo, Epiduo, Differen (adapalene), SkinCeuticals Retinol, Avene Retrinal, and SkinMedica Tri-Retinol or any over the counter retinols for 5-7 days before treatment. (confirm exact number of days with Dr. Black or Cheryl).
- Do not exfoliate 7 days before peel.
- Avoid sun exposure. Wear sunscreen with at least SPF 30 at all times outdoors.
- If you have a history of fever blisters or cold sores, ask Dr. Black, or Cheryl for preventative medication to take for each peel.

After Treatment

- Avoid the following procedures for one week after to your peel:
 - A. Electrolosis B. Waxing C. Depilatory Creams
- Avoid sun exposure. Wear sunscreen with at least SPF 30 at all times outdoors.
- Treat skin mildly and moisturize as needed.
- You can restart your skin care regimen 5 days post peel.
